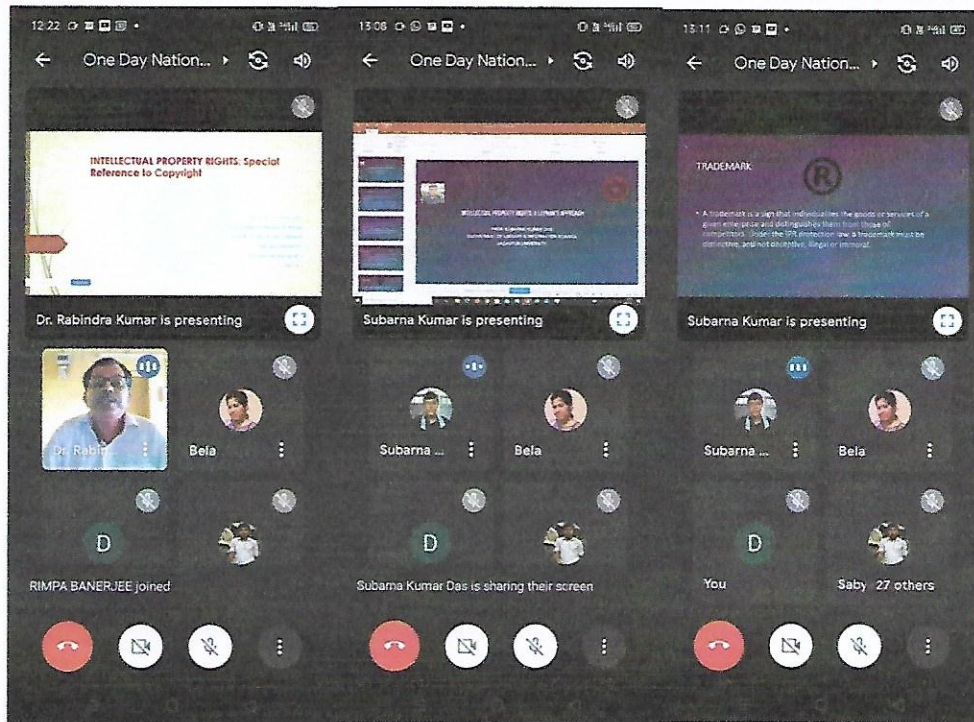
#### About:
