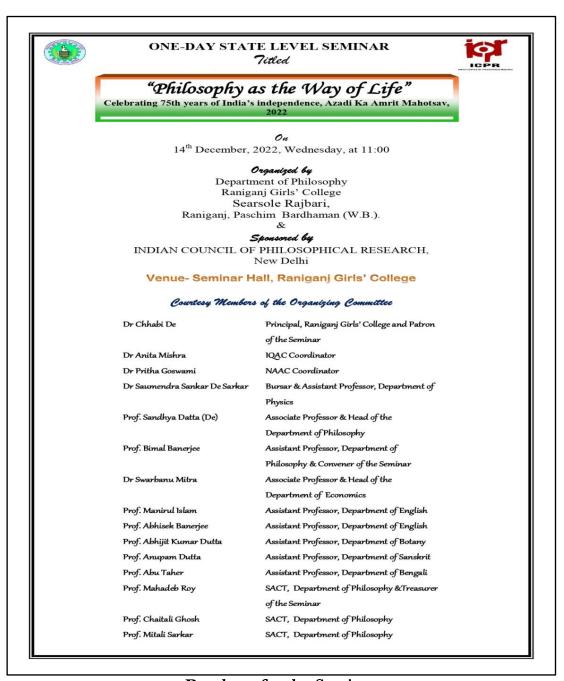
# A Report on One Day State Level Seminar titled "Philosophy as the way of Life"
